
Curriculum Feedback from Alumni







Feedback Analysis

- 1. Adequateness of the courses offered in the programme: A significant majority (87%) rate the adequateness of the courses as excellent, indicating strong approval. The ratings of very good (9%) and good (4%) suggest overall satisfaction with the course offerings.
- 2. Rate the efficiency of the syllabus enabling you to face other aspects of life: Most respondents (89%) find the syllabus highly efficient in preparing them for various aspects of life, with additional strong support from those rating it very good (10%) and good (1%).
- 3. **Relevance of the curriculum in relation to your current professional life**: The curriculum is rated as highly relevant to professional life by the majority (86%). The very good (10%) and good (4%) ratings further underscore its relevance and practical application.
- 4. **Rate the skills acquired from the curriculum for practical exposure in life**: An overwhelming majority (90%) rate the practical skills acquired as excellent, with the remaining 10% rating them very good. This indicates the curriculum is highly effective in imparting practical skills.
- 5. The choice of electives in providing competence in employability skills, communicative and soft skills: The electives are rated as excellent by the majority (83%), with very good (14%) and good (3%) ratings indicating strong support for the effectiveness of the elective choices in providing key skills.
- 6. The design of syllabus prescribed provides room for self-learning: Most respondents (85%) rate the syllabus design for self-learning as excellent, with strong support from very good (13%) and good (1%) ratings. One poor rating (1%) suggests a minor area for improvement.
- 7. The competence and support offered by the institution for the overall development of the students: The majority (80%) rate the institution's competence and support as excellent, with strong additional support from very good (15%) and good (5%) ratings, indicating overall satisfaction with the support provided for student development.
- 8. **Curriculum enhances various co-curricular activities**: Most respondents (88%) find the curriculum excellent in enhancing co-curricular activities, with additional support

from very good (10%) and good (2%) ratings, indicating strong approval of the cocurricular enhancement.

9. Whether syllabus helps you to motivate towards research: A large majority (85%) rate the syllabus as excellent in motivating research, with the remaining 15% rating it very good, indicating strong encouragement towards research activities.
