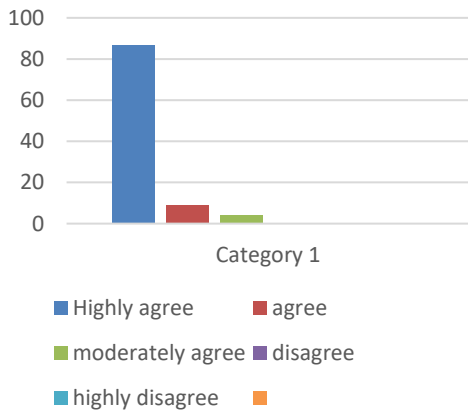

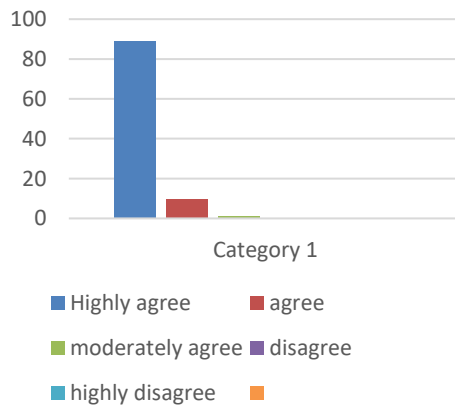

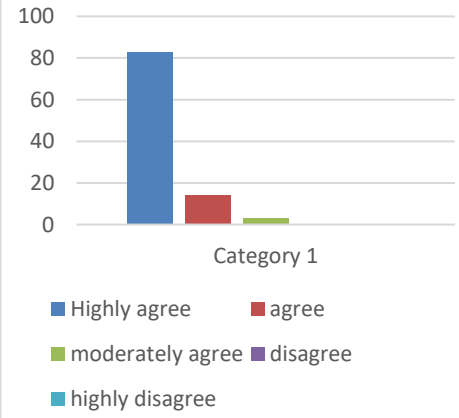
1.The curriculum Enhances Competencies of the Students



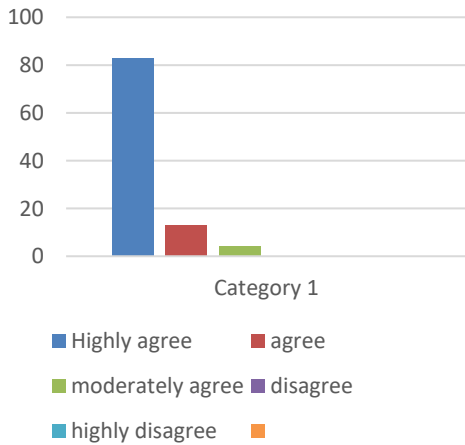
2. Syllabus and teaching methods were appropriate to Students Requirement



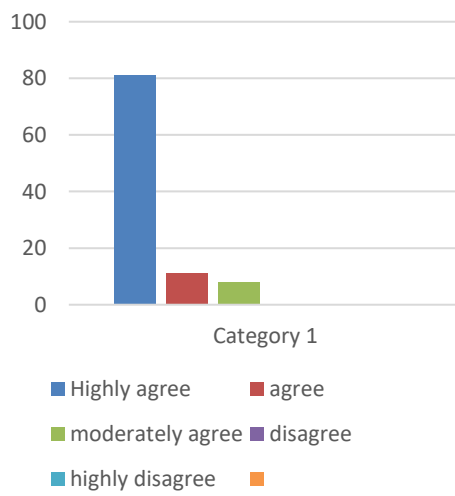
3.Syllabus includes Provision for employability skills and soft skills



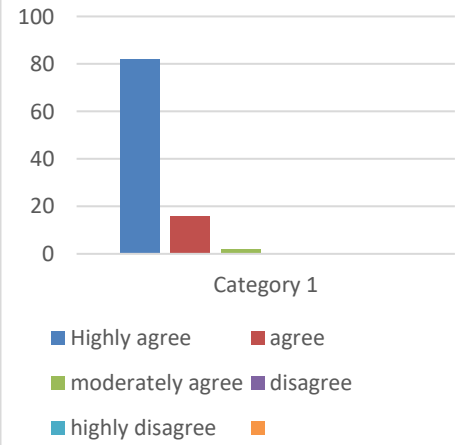
4.Relevance and appropriateness of the units prescribed in the curriculum



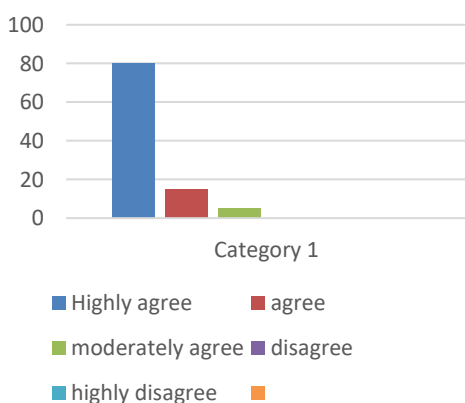

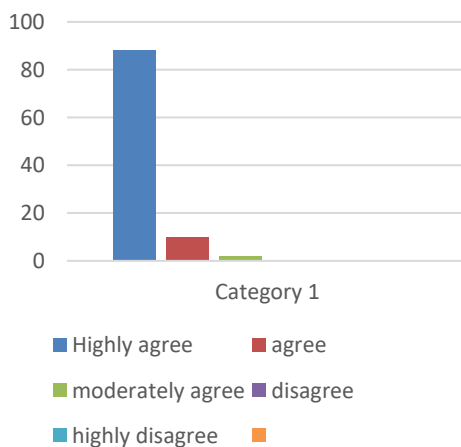

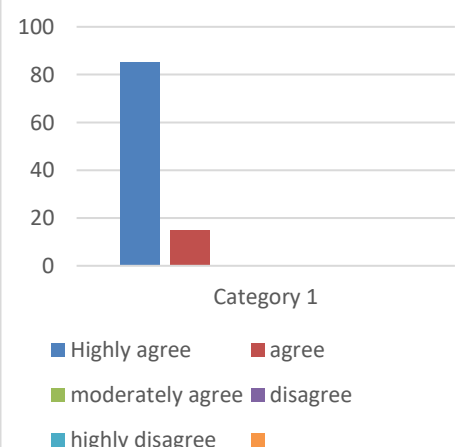
7.The size of the syllabus is in terms of load on the students



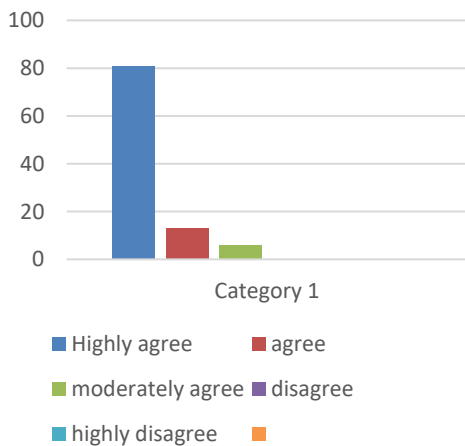

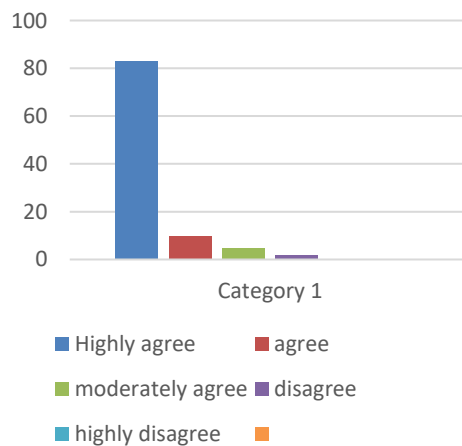

Feedback Analysis

- 1. Adequateness of the courses offered in the programme:** A vast majority (86%) of respondents rated the adequateness of the courses as excellent. This indicates that the courses offered are highly satisfactory, with minimal room for improvement as seen from the very small percentage rating it as good.
- 2. Rate the efficiency of the syllabus enabling you to face other aspects of life:** The efficiency of the syllabus is highly praised, with 90% rating it as excellent. This shows strong satisfaction and confidence in the syllabus's ability to prepare students for various life aspects.
- 3. Relevance of the curriculum in relation to your current professional life:** The curriculum is highly relevant to professional life, as indicated by 83% rating it as excellent. A few respondents rated it as very good or good, suggesting slight variability in perceived relevance.
- 4. Rate the skills acquired from the curriculum for practical exposure in life:** The skills acquired are deemed highly practical, with 85% rating it as excellent. However, the presence of a few lower ratings suggests there might be minor gaps in practical exposure.
- 5. The choice of electives in providing competence in employability skills, communicative, and soft skills:** The choice of electives is well-regarded, with 81% rating it as excellent. However, 8% rated it as good, indicating some room for improving the range or relevance of electives offered.

6. **The design of the syllabus prescribed provides room for self-learning:** The syllabus design strongly supports self-learning, with 86% rating it as excellent. The few lower ratings suggest that while overall positive, some improvements can be made to better facilitate self-learning.
7. **The competence and support offered by the institution for the overall development of the students:** Institutional support and competence are rated highly, with 84% marking it as excellent. This indicates strong institutional backing for student development, with minimal areas for improvement.
8. **Curriculum enhances various co-curricular activities:** The curriculum's enhancement of co-curricular activities is rated highly, with 88% rating it as excellent. The feedback is overwhelmingly positive, indicating a well-rounded curriculum that supports co-curricular engagement.
9. **Whether the syllabus helps you to motivate towards research:** The syllabus effectively motivates students towards research, as seen by 83% rating it as excellent. However, the presence of a few lower ratings suggests there may be opportunities to enhance research motivation.
