NCC and NSS

NSS/NCC REPORT 2020-21

National Cadet Corps is functioning to groom the youth of the country into disciplined, responsible, and patriotic citizens. It is a voluntary organisation which gives basic military training in schools and colleges on a voluntary basis. NCC sub unit in CAS College, Madayi is functioning under the guidance of 32 Keral Battalion NCC, Payyanur. Total strength of our unit is 107. For the personality development and imparting service mentality among the cadets our unit organised various social service activities. The unit is functioning under the guidance of Associate NCC Officer Lt Deepa Mohan.

The National Service Scheme (NSS) is a Central Sector Scheme of Government of India, Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports. It provides opportunity to the student youth of 11th & 12th Class of schools at +2 Board level and student youth of Technical Institution, Graduate & Post Graduate at colleges and University level of India to take part in various Government led community service activities & programmes. The primary objective of developing the personality and character of the student youth through voluntary community service. 'Education through Service' is the purpose of the NSS. NSS was launched in 1969 in 37 Universities involving about 40,000 volunteers which has now spread over 657 Universities and 51 +2 Councils/Directorates, covering 20,669 Colleges/ Technical Institutions and 11,988 Senior Secondary School. Since inception , over 7.4 crore students have benefitted from NSS. In the months of March-April witnessed the outbreak of Corona Virus Disease. The entire world has come to a standstill. Due to the outbreak of COVID-19 and Lockdown most of our activities were switched to online mode.

1. COVID-19 Awareness and Break the Chain Campaign

An awareness **video presentation** made by **SGT Drishya Dinesh** has been noticed.

In this video she stresses the things that do and don't do during the Pandemic period.

Another video made by the cadets to support the ‘**Break the chain Campaign**’ which started by the Govt of Kerala to prevent the spread of **COVID-19**. In this video cadets demonstrated the importance of Handwashing.

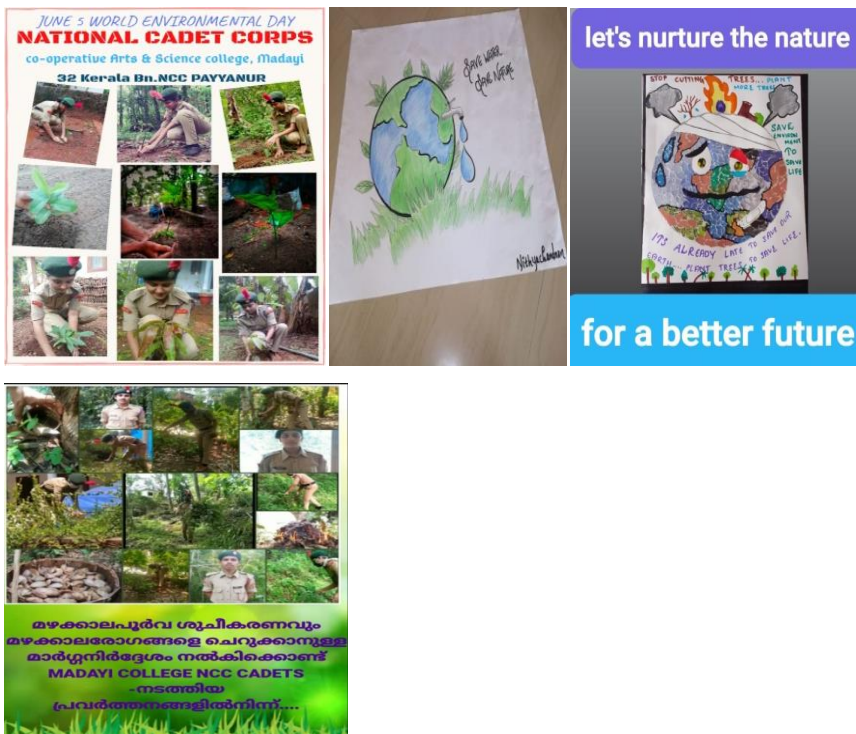
7. Mariya Bhavan visit

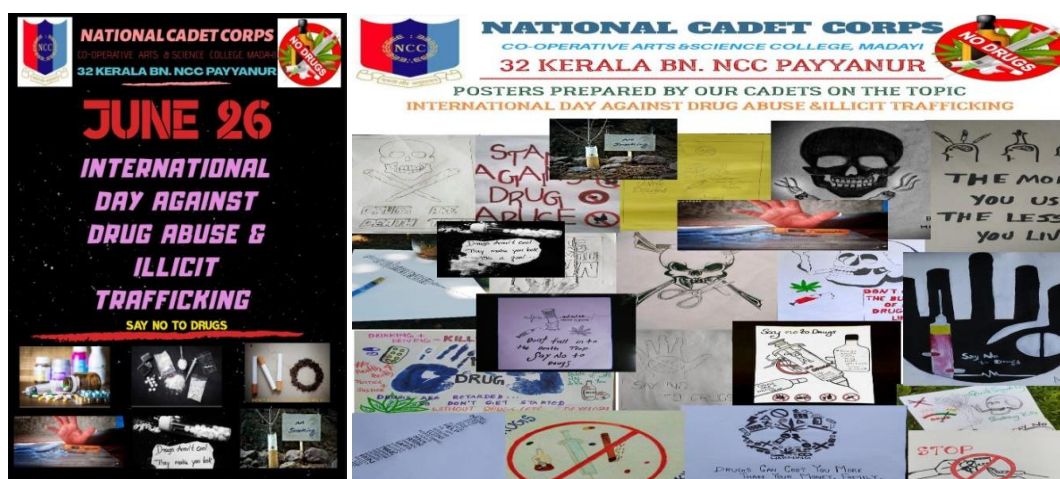
9. International yoga day

10. International Day against drug abuse and illicit trafficking

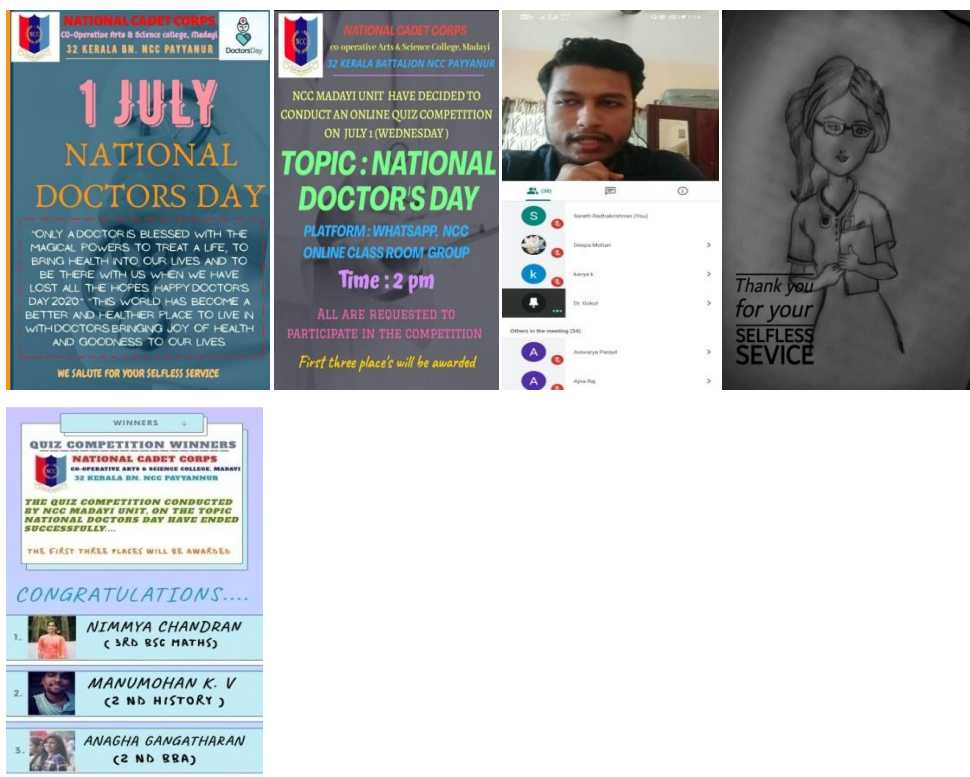

11. National Doctors day

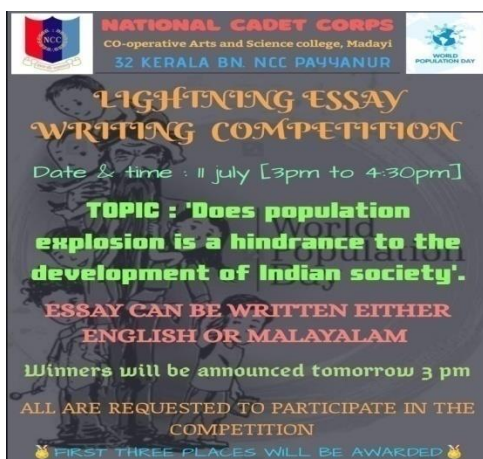

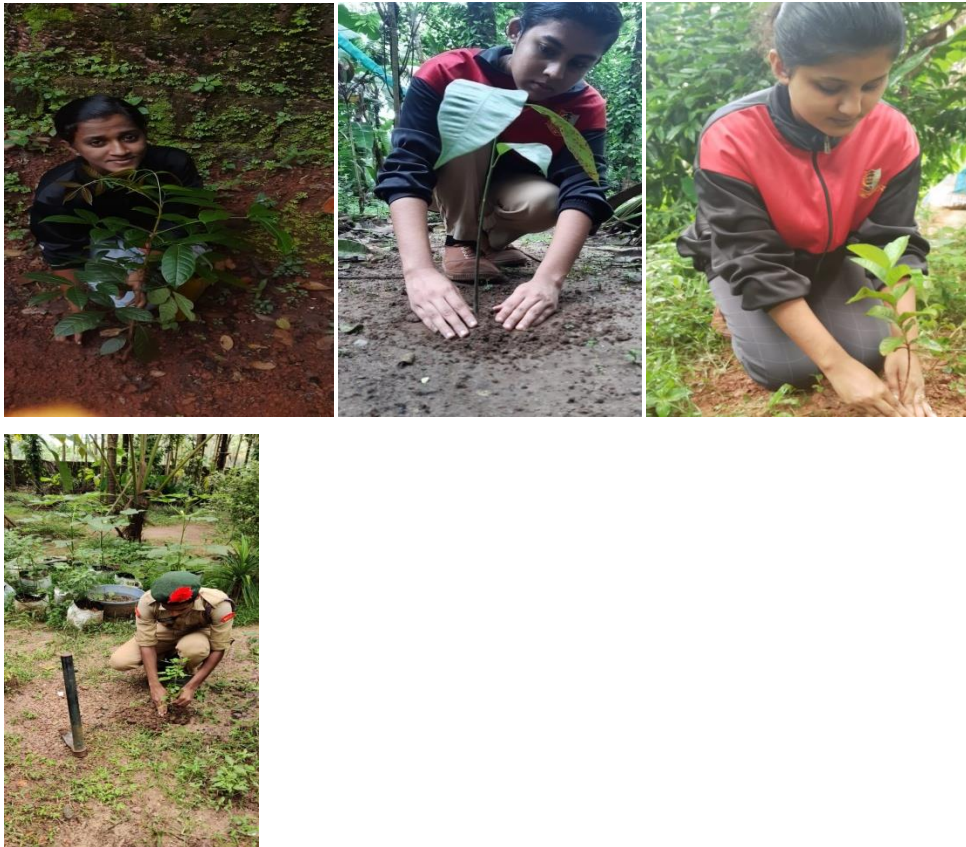
13. Kargil vijay diwas

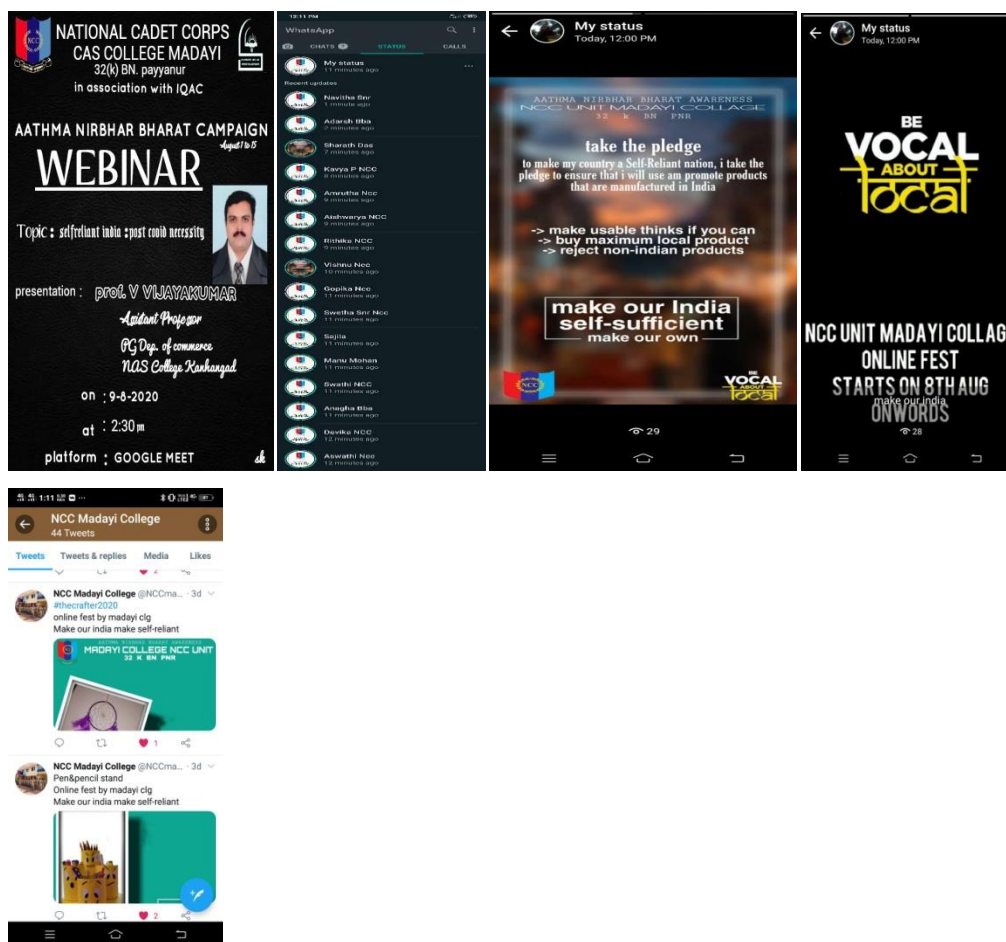

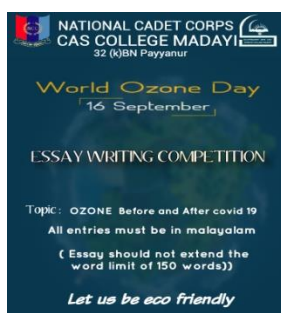
23. Teachers day

Teacher's day was observed by the unit by making a video which express gratitude to all teachers and send it to all the teachers in College. A poster making competition also conducted.



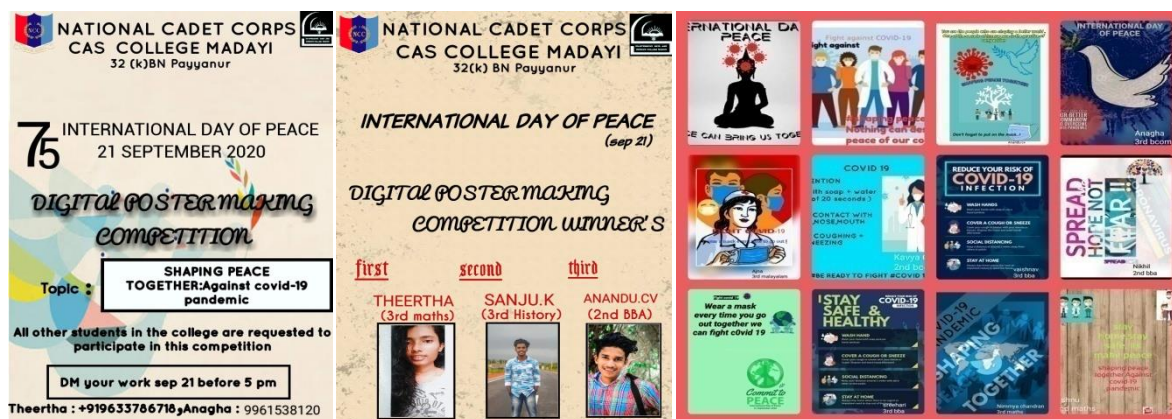
24. Ozone day

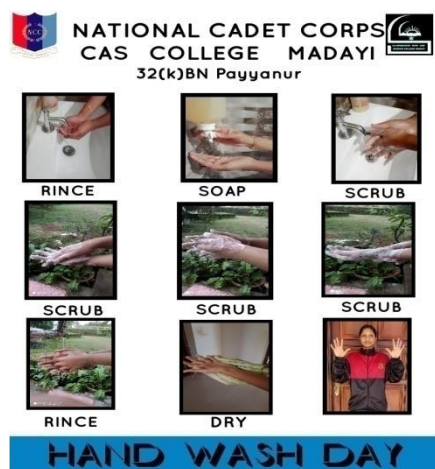


28. Ncc Talent Hunt Competetion



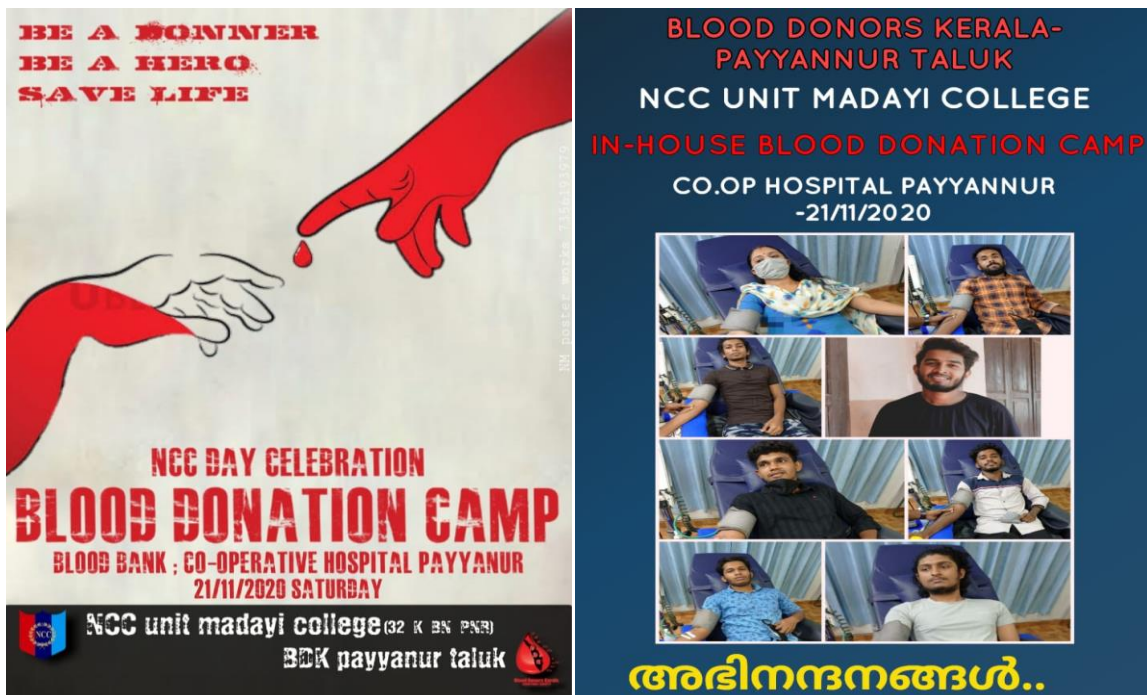


36. NCC DAY

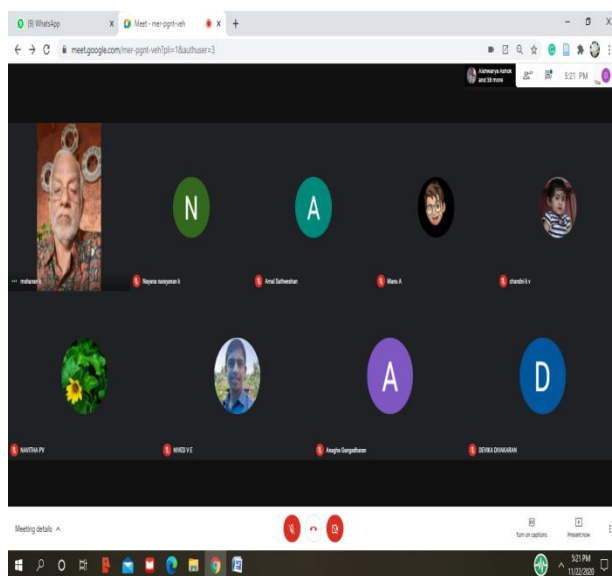
2. Tree Plantation

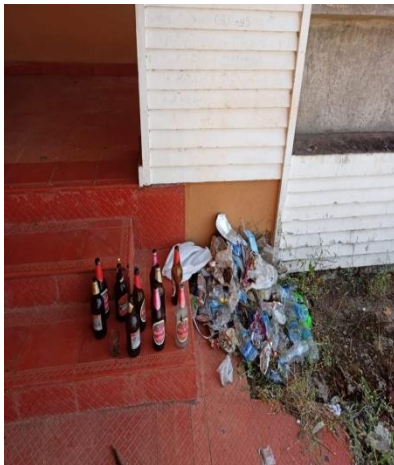
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37. National Pollution Day

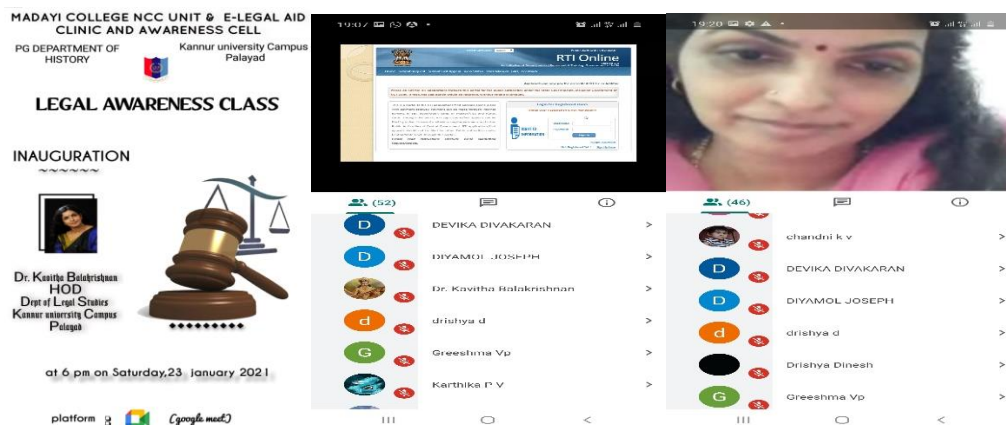

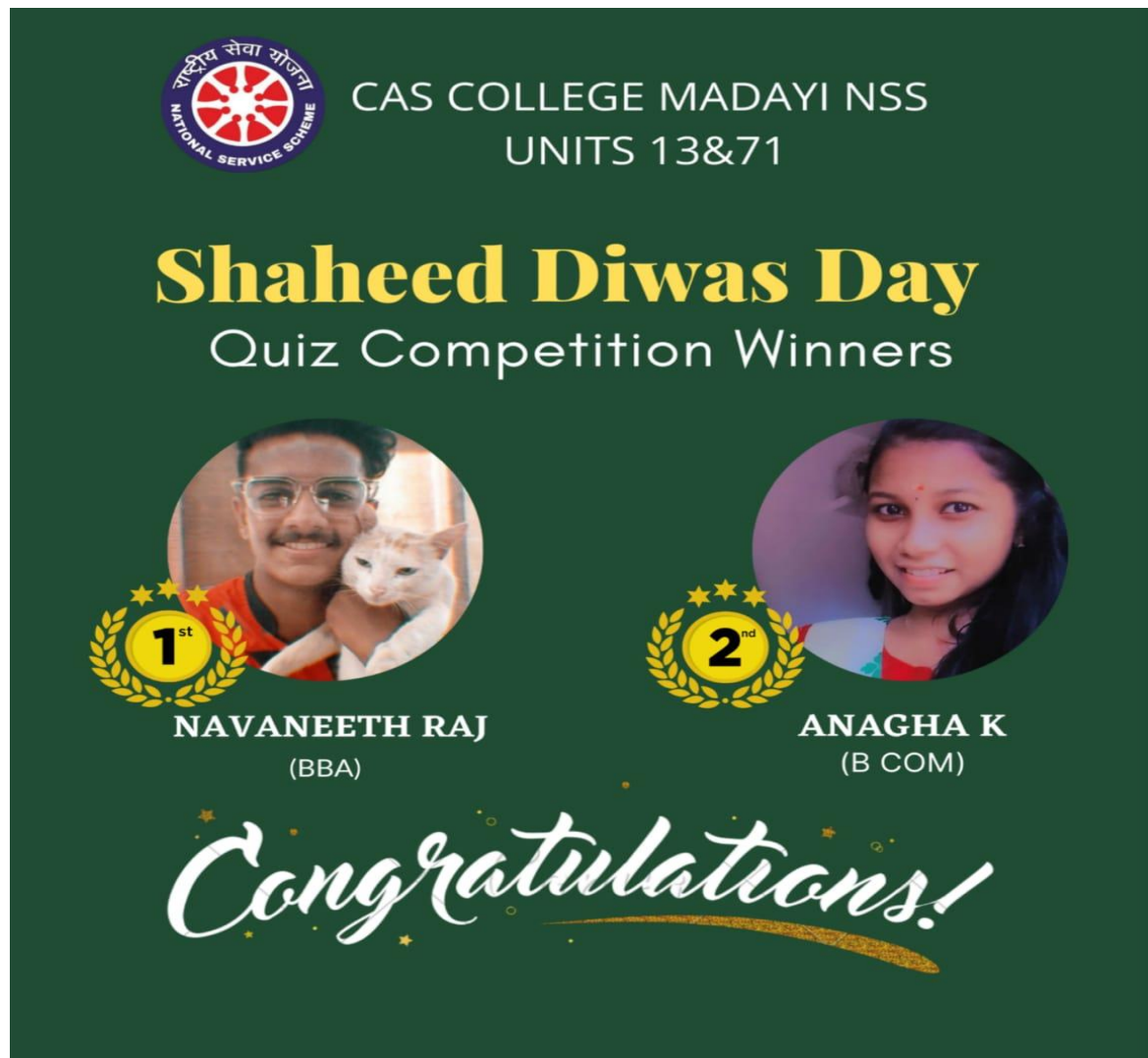
