



Annual Report 2021-22

1. Collaborations with other institutions

1. MATHLAB INSTITUTE COCHIN

Signed a collaboration agreement between the Department of Mathematics, Co-operative Arts and Science College, Madayi and Mathlab institute Cochin, having its Registered Office at Ist floor, Anjikkath Tower, Koonamthai (P O), Edappally, Cochin-682 024, on 15.10.2020. MathLab Research will provide the content of the training of IIT-JAM & Other MSc entrance exams through MathLab institute's official website and that includes recorded videos of theory and problems, pdf materials, tutorials and tests. The students of the department can prepare for their MSc Entrance Examinations with the guidance of faculties of both the institutes. The validity of this collaboration shall be for a period of 2 years starting from the date signed by two parties.

2. PAYYANUR COLLEGE, PAYYANUR

Signed a collaboration agreement between the Department of Mathematics, Cooperative Arts & Science College Madayi, and the Department of Mathematics, Payyanur College, Payyanur on 06/10/2021. Faculty exchange programmes, student exchange programmes and workshops can be conducted in collaboration by both the institutions. Library, Computer lab and other facilities available at both the institutions can be shared. The B.Sc. students of both the institutions can prepare for their MSc Entrance Examinations with the guidance of faculties of both the institutes. Series of problem solving sessions for various MSc Entrance Examinations, called FOCUS, will be organized for their preparation. Collaboration is valid for 3 years from the date signed by two parties.

3. NIRMALAGIRI COLLEGE, KOOTHUPARAMBA

Signed a collaboration agreement between the Department of Mathematics, Co-operative Arts & Science College Madayi, and the Department of Mathematics, Nirmalagiri College, Koothuparamba, on 15.06.2020. Faculty exchange programmes, student exchange programmes and webinars can be conducted in collaboration by both the institutions. The B.Sc. students of both the institutions can prepare for their MSc Entrance Examinations with the guidance of faculties of both the institutes. Collaboration is valid for 3 years from the date signed by two parties.

2. Add-on/Certificate Courses

Department offered numerous add-on courses during the year to provide additional knowledge, skills, or expertise in a specific area related to the main course of study. Following are the details of add-on courses offered by the department.

1. Mathematics for SSC/RAILWAY

Department offered an add-on course on "Mathematics for SSC/RAILWAY " for final year students of BSc Mathematics, BBA and BCOM. Mathematics for SSC (Staff Selection Commission) and Railway exams typically covers a wide range of topics from basic arithmetic to more advanced mathematical concepts. These exams often include questions on quantitative aptitude, numerical ability, and mathematical reasoning. This course helps for the preparation for SSC and Railway exams with a solid understanding of theory along with regular practice. Candidates often benefited from solving previous years' question papers and took mock tests to assess their preparation level and improved time management skills. Additionally, there were many study materials, books, and online resources available specifically designed for SSC and Railway exam preparation, which can provide further guidance and practice opportunities. The course started on 15 November 2022 and a total of 40 hours of classes (theory and practical) were provided in the academic year 2021-22.

2. Latex

Department offered an Add-on Course on "LATEX " for second year BSc Mathematics students (2020-23 Batch). LaTeX is a typesetting system commonly used for producing documents with complex layouts, such as academic papers, theses, resumes, reports, and presentations. It's particularly popular in fields like mathematics, computer science, engineering, and academia due to its ability to handle complex mathematical equations and produce high-quality, professional-looking documents. The outcome of this course is to equip students with the knowledge and skills necessary to effectively create, format, and manage documents using LaTeX, enabling them to produce high-quality, professional-looking documents for academic, professional, or personal

purposes. The course started on 15 November 2022 and a total of 40 hours of classes (theory and practical) were provided in the academic year 2021-22.

3. The Fundamentals of Computers

Department offered an add-on course on "The Fundamentals of Computers " for second year students of BA History, BA Malayalam & BA English. Overall, the outcome of this course is to equip students with the knowledge and skills necessary to use computers effectively and responsibly in various contexts, whether it's in academic, professional, or personal settings. The course started on 15 November 2022 and a total of 40 hours of classes (theory and practical) were provided in the academic year 2021-22.

3. Other Academic Activities

1. Bridge Course

Department offers a Bridge Course for BSc Mathematics students. Aim of the course is to revisit the topics of Mathematics from secondary classes that will be helpful in the undergraduate studies. Theory classes and worksheet solving sessions were organized in each semester. The course started in the beginning of each semester and a total of 30 hours of classes were provided in each semester.

2. Remedial Classes

After the first internal examination, the tutor of each class identified the students with poor academic performance and recommended remedial teaching for them. Remedial classes will be arranged according to the needs. This helped students to catch up with their peers and improve their academic performance. Remedial teaching also helped to build students' self-confidence and motivation, as they see progress in their learning.

3. Group Study

Group study is a common approach in educational settings where students work together to prepare for exams or complete group assignments. The Tutors of each class divided the students into groups of three or four students. Each group contains students of different academic levels. Tutor gave assignments for class and each group worked on it. One or two hours in a week allotted for group study. The assignments may be questions of previous year competitive examinations, or university examinations, or something related to mathematics. This approach of group study allows for collaboration, sharing of ideas, and can facilitate a deeper understanding of the subject matter. Additionally, group study helped to reduce stress and increase motivation, as students can support and encourage each other.

4. Department Programmes

1. Orientation class for MSc Mathematics entrance examinations:

Department organized a orientation class for MSc Mathematics entrance examinations (IIT JAM, CUSAT, CUET, Hyderabad university, Pondichery university, etc) in collaboration with Mathlab institute, Cochin. The program conducted through online at 7pm on 19th August 2021.

2. Shiju K Memorial endowment distribution program

Department organized Shiju K Memorial endowment distribution program on 10th September 2021 through Google Meet. The program was in association with Alumni Association. 2018-21 batch topper Devika. All BScathematics students benefitted the session.

5. FOCUS Inauguration
