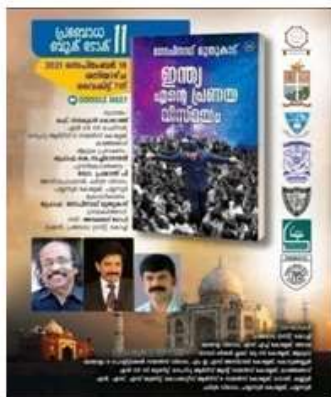
Environment study camp 16/08/2021

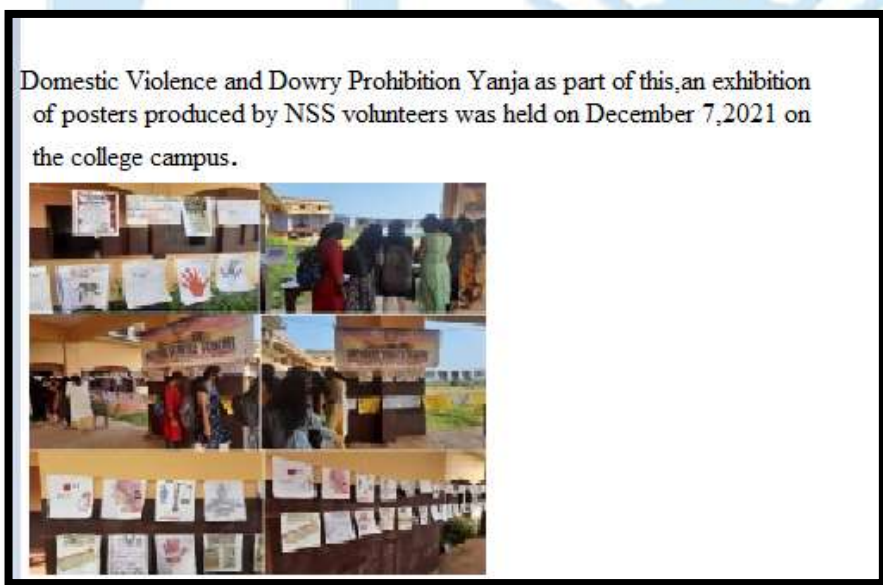
Covid-19 related programme

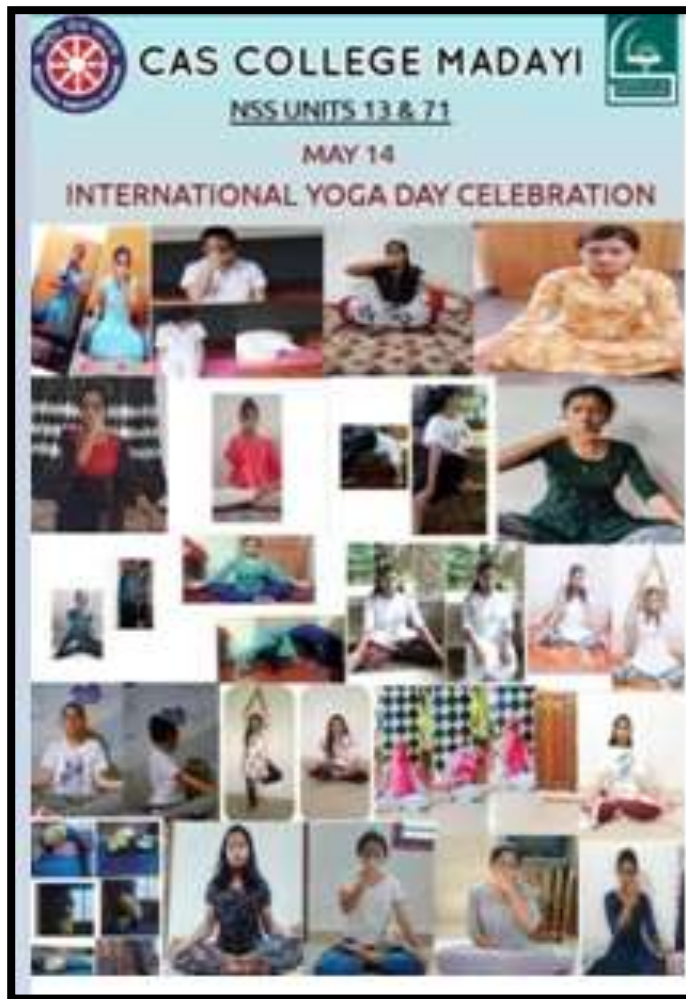
Mothers Day Celebration 08/05/2022

Anti-Tobacco Day 31 May

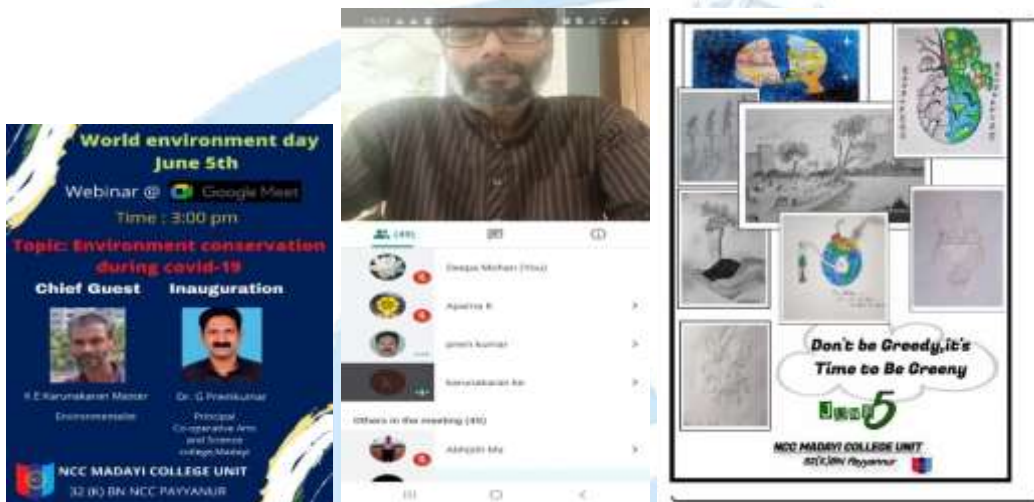

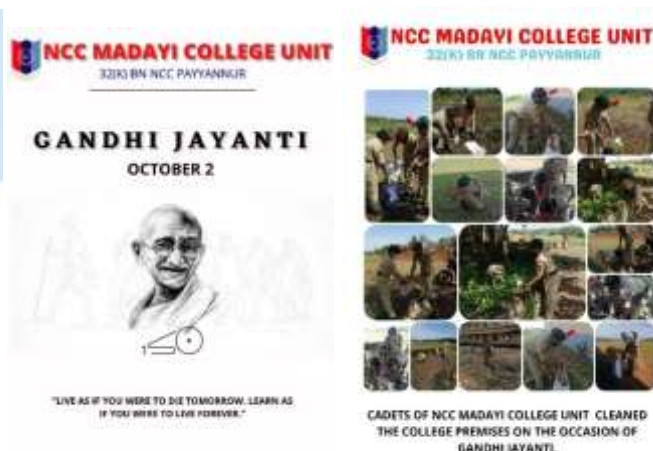
As part of World Heart Day, the unit organized Drawing competition and essay writing competition .

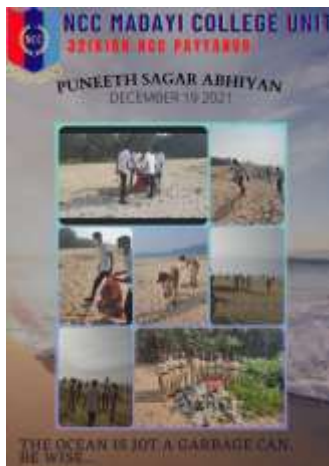


PUNEETH SAGAR ABHIYAN 19 December

Unit organised Pulwama Day to remember the brave soldiers who lost their life in Pulwama attack.

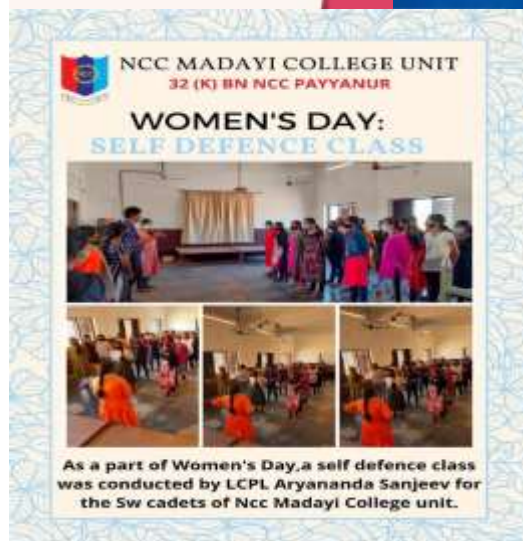
